I would like to express my support for a 4-Way Stop at the intersection of 32<sup>nd</sup> Ave W and W Raye St in Magnolia. I am the store director for Albertsons, which is located right next to this intersection, across the street from Catharine Blaine K-8. Specifically what I would like to see is "Establishing Right of Way Control" to the intersection at 32<sup>nd</sup> Ave West and Raye St.

I'm in support of anything we can do to make this a safer intersection. Drivers regularly speed down 32<sup>nd</sup> Ave W, which presents a danger to the kids crossing to school, as well as to my customers and employees. I am concerned that the danger presented along this stretch could lead to a tragic event.

One of my employees has reported the danger of these cars speeding while he has been unloading pallets using a forklift. Without looking or slowing down, drivers have swerved around him, nearly hitting him. This is a danger that I don't want my employees to have to face.

As a Business that is here to serve the community I hope that you are able to appropriate funds for this project. The proposal for the city to install a four way stop at this intersection would go a long way to forcing drivers to obey the speed limit on this street. I hope the city considers funding this proposal.
