Re: Support for a 4-way stop at the intersection of 32nd Ave W and W Raye St in Magnolia (98199)

Our Lady of Fatima Parish (Church and School) is very happy to support the establishing right of way control at 32nd Ave. W. and W. Raye St. in the Magnolia neighborhood.

Many students, parents, and parishioners from Our Lady of Fatima cross through the intersection in both directions on a daily basis while going to or from school, shopping, or using the Mounger Pool when it is in operation. This intersection may be the busiest in the Magnolia community and one of the most dangerous in terms of pedestrian safety. Vehicle traffic is very heavy almost anytime of the day, but especially during the mornings and afternoons when the school day to Catharine Blaine and Our Lady of Fatima begins and ends.

We strongly support the installation of a 4-way stop and would also encourage the consideration of a permanently reduced speed limit on 32nd Ave. W.
